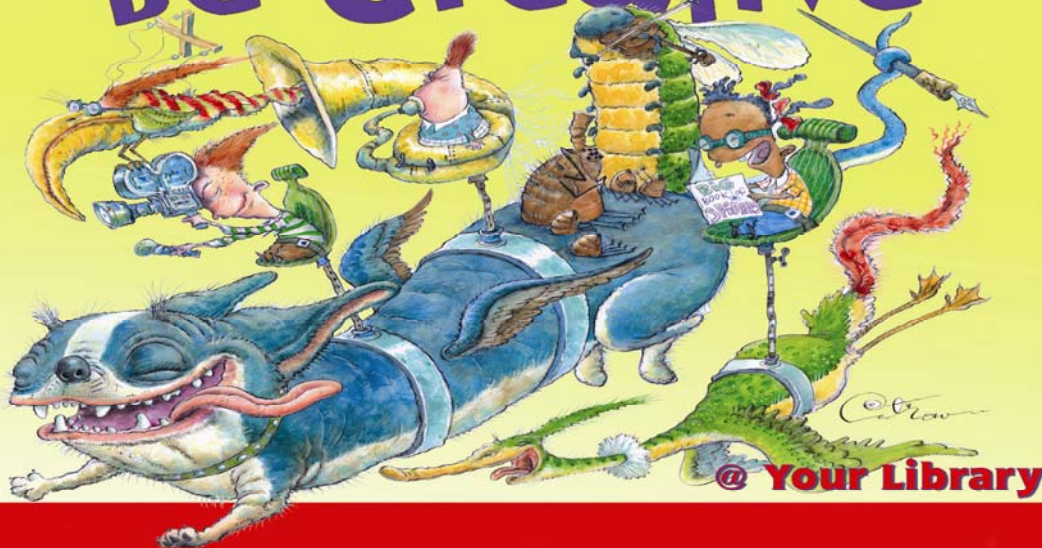

- In signing this contract you promise to read or listen to 5 or more books by **Friday, August 7, 2009.**
