


We pulled out our graphic novels and made them a featured collection. You may or may not want to do this. That is the beauty of a method vs. system. Make it work for your community.





#### Browse Method

#### THE BROWSE METHOD!

The Cumberland Public Library is pleased to offer a new organization system for adult nonfiction sections (for free!) to libraries that wish to use a more patron-friendly shelving method.

- . You are only changing a call #, so it can be used with any ILS and consortium
- · The method is completely ready to implement in your library!
- Ditch Dewey (or LC) for good! The new call # will begin with a 4-digit finder number. No more
  decimals, no more having books on the same topic in several sections of the collection, or even
  the same title on two different places on the same shelf.
- Spine labels will use plain English (or language of your choice) and color coding for patron
  accessibility. They will feel empowered to browse your collection and feel confident that they
  will find what they need without having to search out a librarian (which they may not want to

### A Special Note

- This method was never intended for school, special, academic, or historical libraries as is. We would love if it could be modified for that, but please be aware that we never intended this to be a one fix solution across the library spectrum- just for adult nonfiction public library collections.
  - We cannot stress enough the importance of moving into new systems- but they have to be designed for the needs of that demographic. Our children's department head has expressed an interest in incorporating this in her department, but we would first need to adapt it for that collection's needs.


