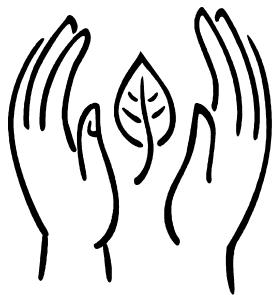
MONETARY CONTRIBUTIONS

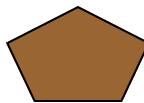

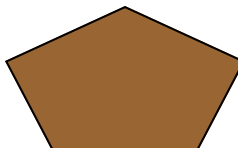
